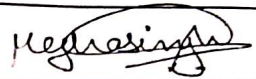
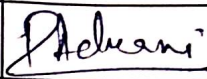
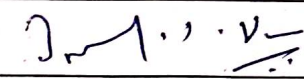

If yes, what are the expenses outlay?

Minutes :

AACSB Accreditation

The purpose, expenses, and expected benefits of AACSB accreditation were discussed with Trustees. The global expansion is a key part of the institute's strategic plan, and multiple opportunities should be explored before the full implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP).

The importance of achieving Triple Crown Accreditation i.e AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA for institutional growth was discussed. Benefits of AACSB accreditation include enhancement of educational quality, increased revenue opportunities, greater acceptance in international academic exchanges, which is currently lacking due to the absence of global accreditation, and overall progressive improvement in institutional standards.

It was also discussed that competitor institutes like SIES and NL Dalmia have recently initiated their journey towards international accreditation.

Minutes :

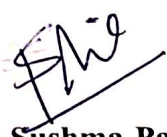
It was discussed that the proposed Commercial Pilot Training Program, which aims to offer comprehensive training, personalized mentorship, and support leading up to final placements.

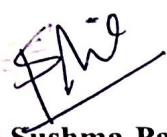

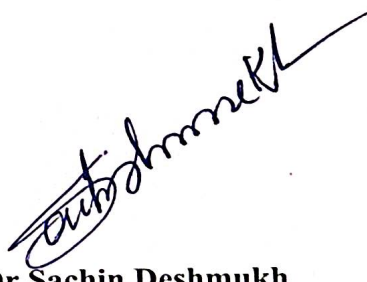
Agenda 12: Any other matter with the permission of chair
