1. To inculcate the habit of innovation among students.

For encouraging innovation among students, they need to be provided with opportunities to explore entrepreneurship and turn their innovative ideas into viable products or services. To foster an environment of creativity every student is asked to come up with a business plan, explore new innovative idea which can be implemented and measured.

2. To consider introduction of fintech course.

Associate Dean Academics, Dr. Brijesh Sharma, is in talks with NSE (National Stock Exchange) to introduce fintech courses. It will be implemented for the batch 2025-26. Subjects will be focused on understanding of the fintech ecosystem, its evolution, and its impact on traditional financial institutions and markets.

4. Library Policy – Inclusion of visitor entry card.

IQAC suggested addition to library policy should include visitor entry card with in time and out time to be maintained.

The visitor entry card allows individuals to obtain a temporary entry card, granting them access to library resources. The college librarian shall check the visitors identification proof, and then issue a temporary entry card along with instruction on accessing library services and resources.

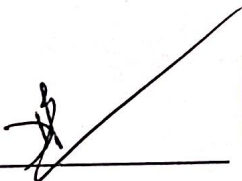

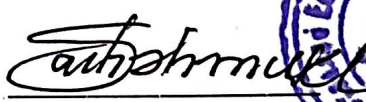
