**1. To discuss eligibility criteria for foreign students**

VBS has received approval of 27 additional seats specifically for international students.

The key points discussed for accepting admission and the proposed criteria for accepting admissions are listed below:

- **Academic Qualifications:**

Applicants must be graduates with a minimum CGPA of 2.75.

- **Entrance Examination:**

Applicants should clear the G-MAT eligibility test.

- **Supporting Documentation:**

A justifying letter of intent or statement of purpose is required.

Applicants should submit two references.

- **Language skills:**

Applicants must clear either the IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or

TOEFL (Test Of English as a Foreign Language).

**The institute plans to attract target students from countries such as listed below:**

Nepal, Myanmar, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Sri Lanka, South Africa, Pakistan (with ref to Pakistan, preference will be given only to Sindhi minority students)

**2. To discuss the faculty classification as per AACSB Business Accreditation standard 2020 and linking performance appraisal emphasizing to the identified faculty classification**

**(AACSB- Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business)**

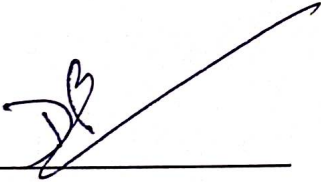

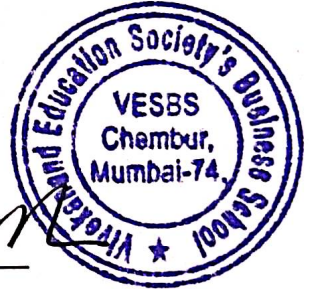
